

VP Competitive report for 2021-2022 season

A total of 178 athletes registered and participated in tryouts for the newly formed Castor River Canucks Rep B program. Of the 8 teams, Russell Minor Hockey hosted 2 and Metcalfe Minor Hockey hosted 6. Tryouts started in early September for U12-U15 age categories with the U10 and U11s following the Hockey Canada pathway shortly after. The U16 and U18 age groups concluded tryouts in early October so it was a very long month.

Once the teams were formed, the brand-new jerseys were proudly presented to the teams.

U10

- Initial rep season

- Tournament Champs in Bradford
- Finalist in Montreal
- Participated in the Regional Silverstick

U13

- Kids stayed engaged despite finishing last in league play
- Managed 2 wins
- Possible merge with Leitrim to help with low numbers

U14

- Finished 9th in the league just outside of playoffs
- 2 tournament participants
- Lots of team building and fun activities including the Terry Fox Run, paintball
- Friendly game with the Ottawa Bandits
- Yearend banquet

U15

- 9th place 1 point out of the playoffs
- Participated in 5 tournaments
- Won bronze in Canadian Cup in Montreal

U16

- 2nd place in the league losing only 4 games all season
- Won the Perth Tournament early in the season
- Upset in first game of playoffs in overtime

U18

- Only B team in District 9
- 9th in league play losing 1st game of playoffs to top team
- All players were 1st year of U18 and therefore eligible to come back next year
- Participated in 2 tournaments

Moving forward, Russell Minor Hockey will always be hosting the U11 and U13 teams while Metcalfe will host the remaining teams unless there is a special partnership with letrim which is on a year to year basis.
