Executive Summary

Operational Improvements

Convenors Guidebook

- A comprehensive **Convenors Guidebook** was developed and shared with the President and convenor group
- This initiative ensures:
 - Standardized processes across all divisions
 - Improved consistency in decision-making
 - Clear expectations and accountability for convenors

This is a significant step forward in aligning operations and improving the overall efficiency of the program.

Evaluation & Development Innovation

Skillshark Pilot Project

- Approved pilot for **Skillshark scoring system** for U11–U15 evaluations
- Objective:
 - Improve transparency and objectivity in player assessments
 - Enhance team balancing outcomes

- Provide better data-driven insights for coaches and evaluators

Expected Impact:

- More consistent evaluations year-over-year
- Better player placement and development alignment
- Reduced subjectivity in team formation

Priorities for Next Season

- **Refine team balancing processes**
 - Incorporate data from Skillshark pilot
 - Improve evaluation consistency
- **Expand use of data-driven decision making**
 - Leverage evaluation tools to support fairness and development
- **Continue operational standardization**
 - Full adoption and refinement of the Convenors Guidebook
